On December 19, 1777, George Washington and the Continental Army arrived at Valley Forge.


There were soldiers at the Valley Forge Encampment from each of the thirteen colonies.

Can you match each colony with its name?





2	Marquis de Lafayette	B.	Boston bookseller who became Brigadier General
3	Hannah Till	C.	Lutheran minister of Virginia turned soldier
4	Henry Knox	D.	Commander in chief of the Continental Army
5	Joseph Plumb Martin	E.	One of General Washington's cooks
6	Nathanael Greene	F.	Washington's worthy wife
7	Peter Muhlenberg	G.	General from Rhode Island who recommended the enlistment of blacks
8	Patrick Henry	H.	Young French nobleman who sailed to America's aid
9	Martha Washington	J.	Connecticut soldier who later published an account of his wartime experiences
10	Baron von Steuben	K.	Arrogant soldier of fortune who opposed Washington
11	James Varnum	L.	Quaker turned soldier; quartermaster general at Washington's request
12	Elizabeth Stephens	M.	French officer of German birth who came to America with Lafayette
13	Anthony Wayne	N.	Continued to live in her farm house while General Varnum rented a room upstairs
14	Johann de Kalb	O.	Virginia governor who sent a bounty of supplies
15	Alexander Hamilton	P.	Fiery Continental officer from Chester County
16.	Thomas Conway	Q.	Aide-de-camp to General Washington
