National Park Foundation Hill Day 2024





Valley Creek Cleanup, April 6

Valley Forge Trout Unlimited is seeking volunteers to participate in the cleanup of Valley Creek from 9:00 AM-noon on Saturday, April 6. Volunteers are to meet at Valley Creek Park on Route 29, East Whiteland Township, Malvern, PA. The clean-up will run rain or shine unless the stream is out of its banks.

We will supply trash bags and gloves. We will assign stream segments to individuals and groups and advise where to drop off their filled bags of trash.

Please dress appropriately for the weather, walking stream side or in-stream and collecting trash. Please bring your own hydration. You should consider wearing long sleeves and sun protection. Hip boots or waders are recommended.
